- ✓ Tools for assessing learning levels are essential elements for getting quick and accurate feedback from students or participants in a training course.
- ✓ Web 2.0 tools can give teachers or presenters an immediate account of "learners'" progress through new interactive elements compared to traditional assessment tools.

EVALUATION DURING THE PRESENTATION



- ✓ You can ask "yes/no" questions or open-ended questions where you can put together participants' comments and suggestions in 2-3 words.
- ✓ This way you can have short "brainstorming" sessions and show them to each participant or ask for the opinion of the "audience" who can express their agreement or disagreement.

EVALUATION DURING THE PRESENTATION



- ✓ It is very useful to use these tools when speaking in front of a large audience, such as a group of 2-3 classes of students, and you want students to continue to interact.
- ✓ These tools ensure anonymity and encourage interaction even among those who, due to shyness, are not normally willing to interact and share their views.

EVALUATION AT SCHOOL



- ✓ In schools, surveys can be conducted quickly without having to arrive at a result through lengthy discussions.
- ✓ Brainstorming, such as collecting ideas from students or from previous activities to prepare new topics, is also easier when stimulated with these tools.

- ✓ Edmodo is a global educational network that helps connect all students with the people and resources they need to reach their full potential.
